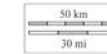

It maintains government-wide ICT solutions and common standards, that **simplify the communication** between authorities, citizens and businesses.

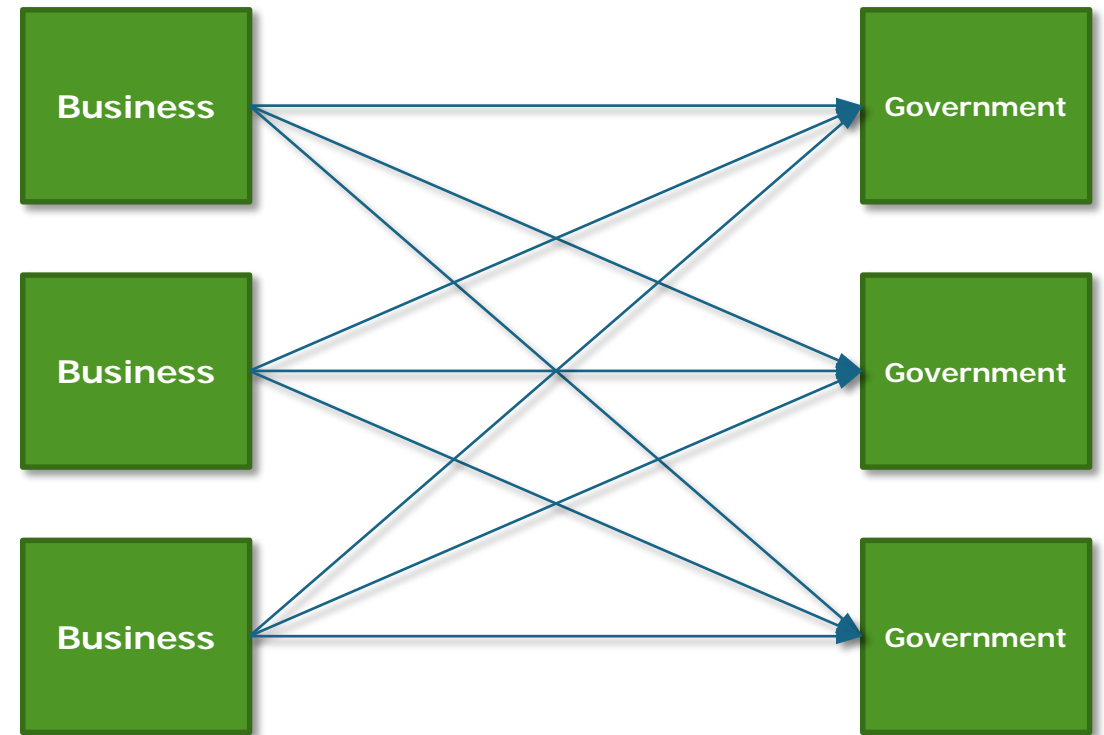

# What is Digipoort

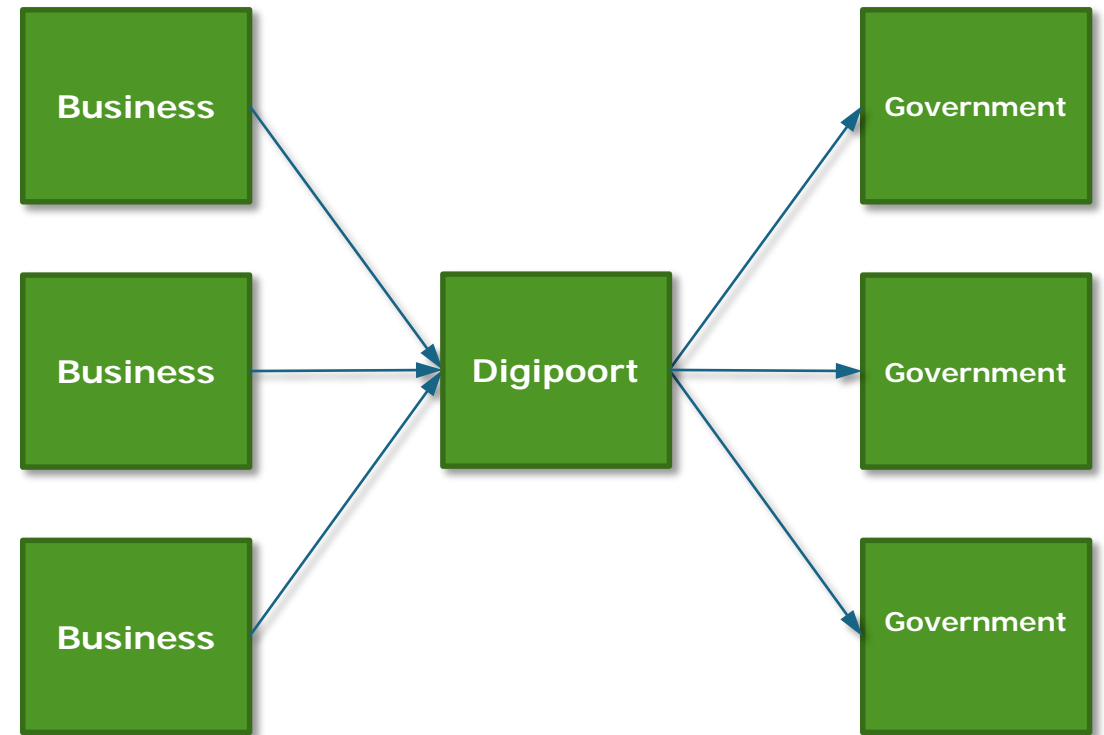
- › Demand for digital, **system-to-system** information exchange; both government and business
- › Declaration of **Tallinn** and **Digital Single Market Strategy** call for interoperability
- › Need for uniformity, based on **open standards**





# What is Digipoort

- › Digipoort is the **digital gateway** for B2G and G2G information exchange
- › **Standardization** of communication
- › Data exchange based on **laws & regulations**
- › Uniform application programming interface (**API**)





# Why Digipoort & SBR

2003:

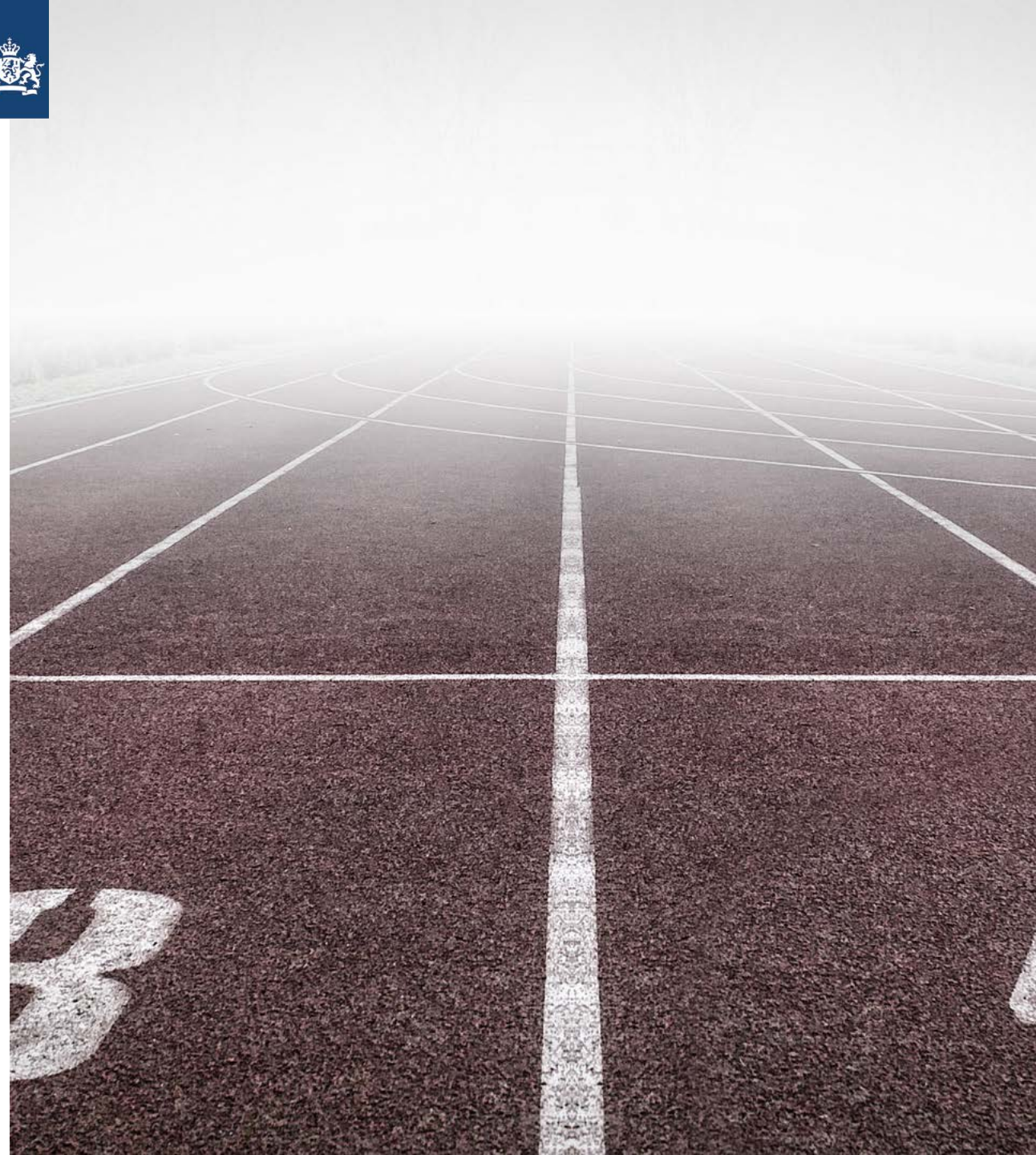
- › Administrative burden on businesses relatively high
- › **€ 13-16 billion\*** /year
- › 2.9-3.7% GDP





# Reduce the burden

- › **Preventing** new regulatory burdens
- › **High-trust** approach  
(cooperation private sector)
- › **Smart Regulation**  
(cooperation EU)
- › Improving level of service,  
including ICT: **Standard  
Business Reporting**  
→ € 350-900 million /year







## Why Digipoort & SBR

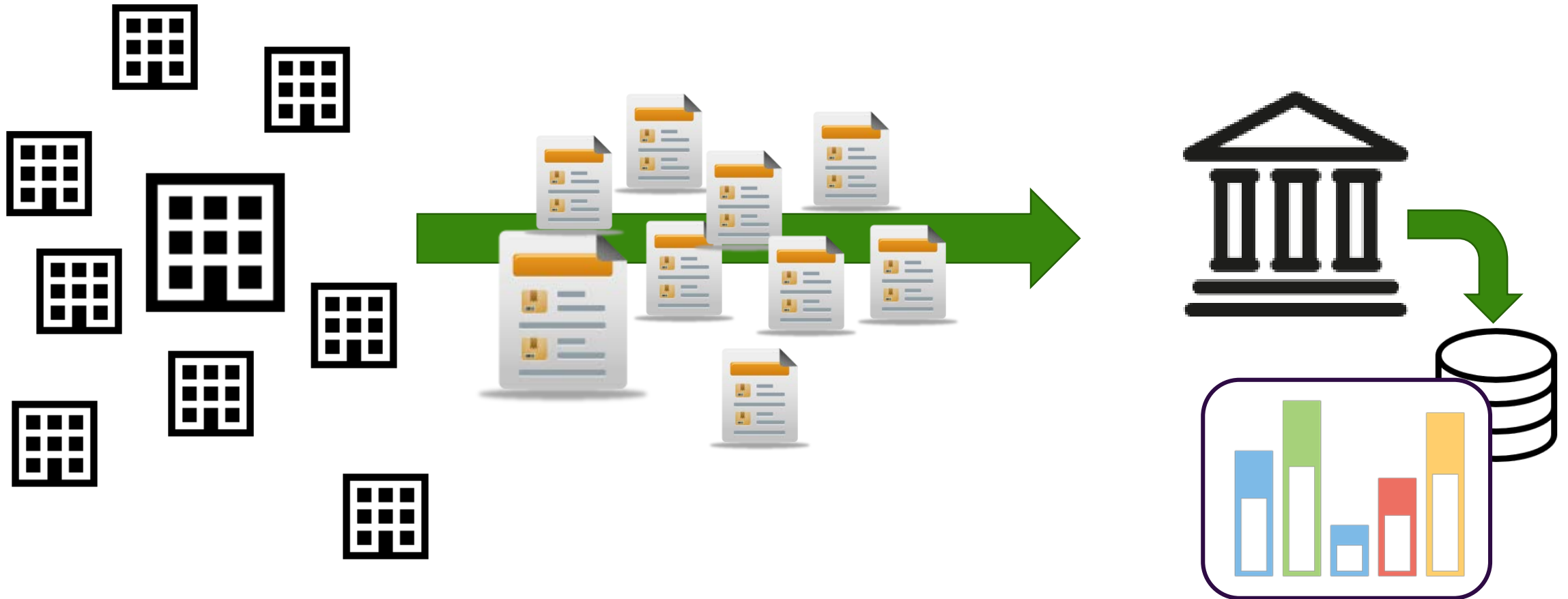
Eliminate obstacles for automation:

- › **Machine-to-machine** reporting



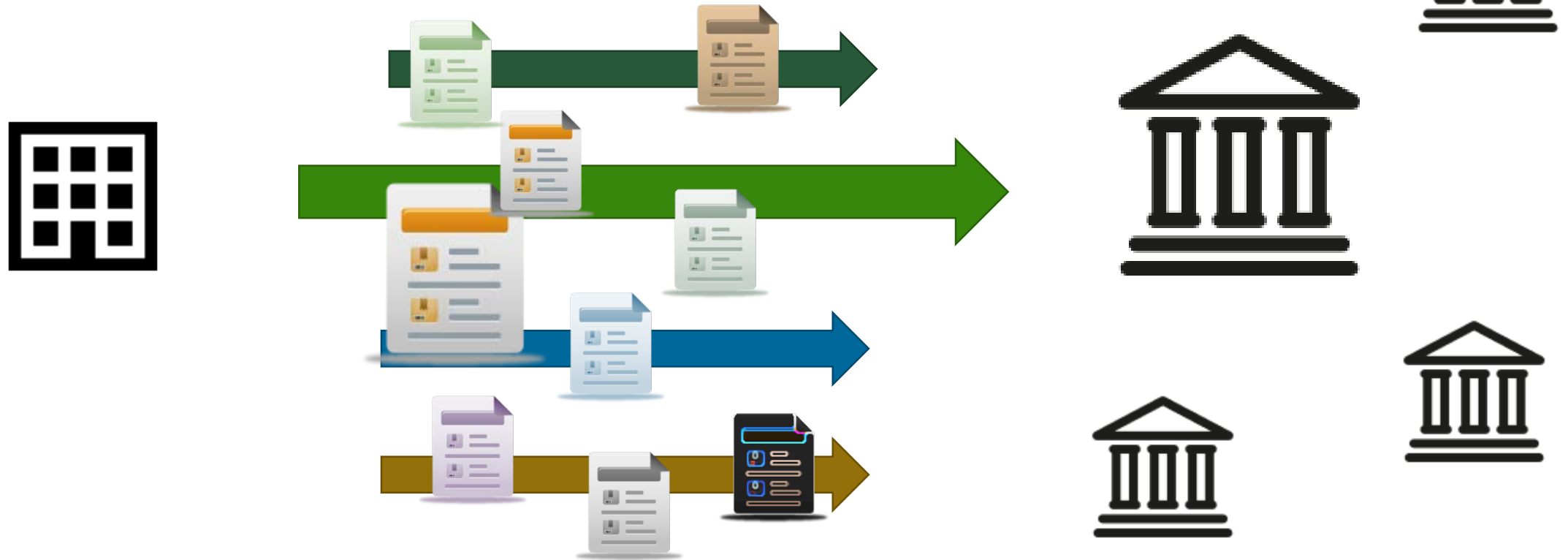

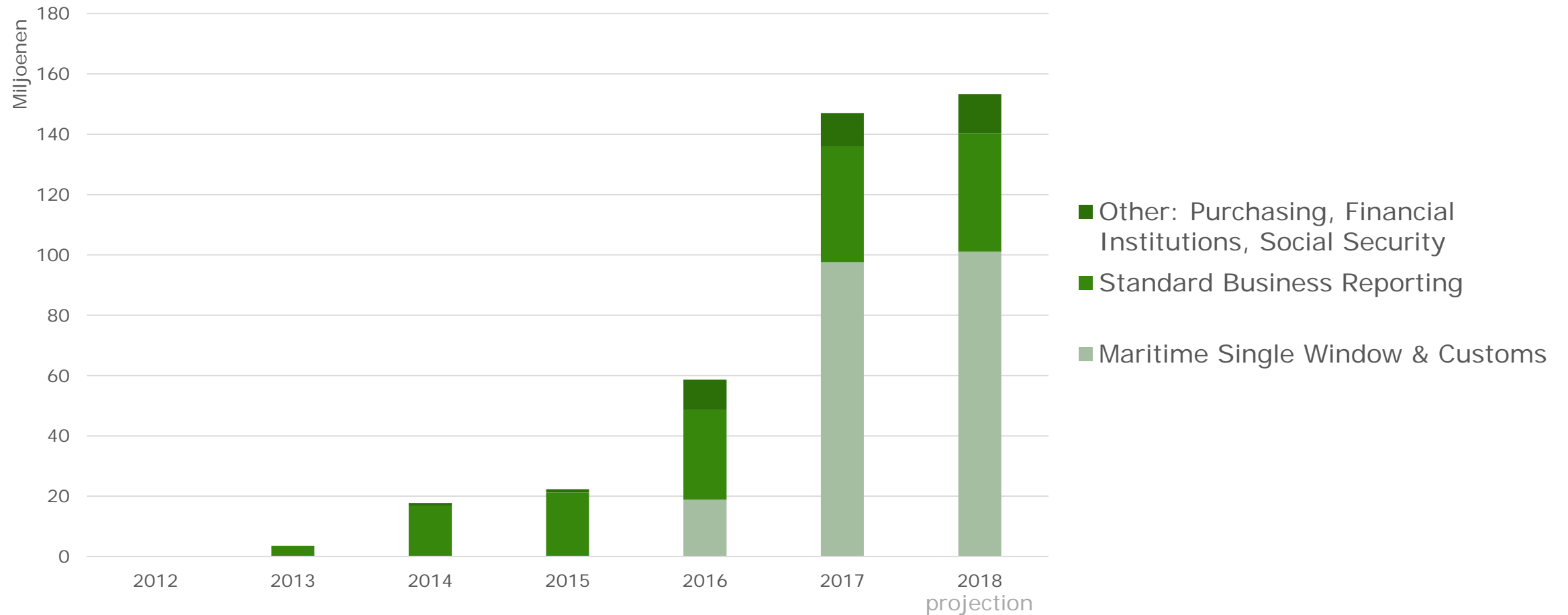
## Results & lessons learnt

→ competition, **innovation**, transparency





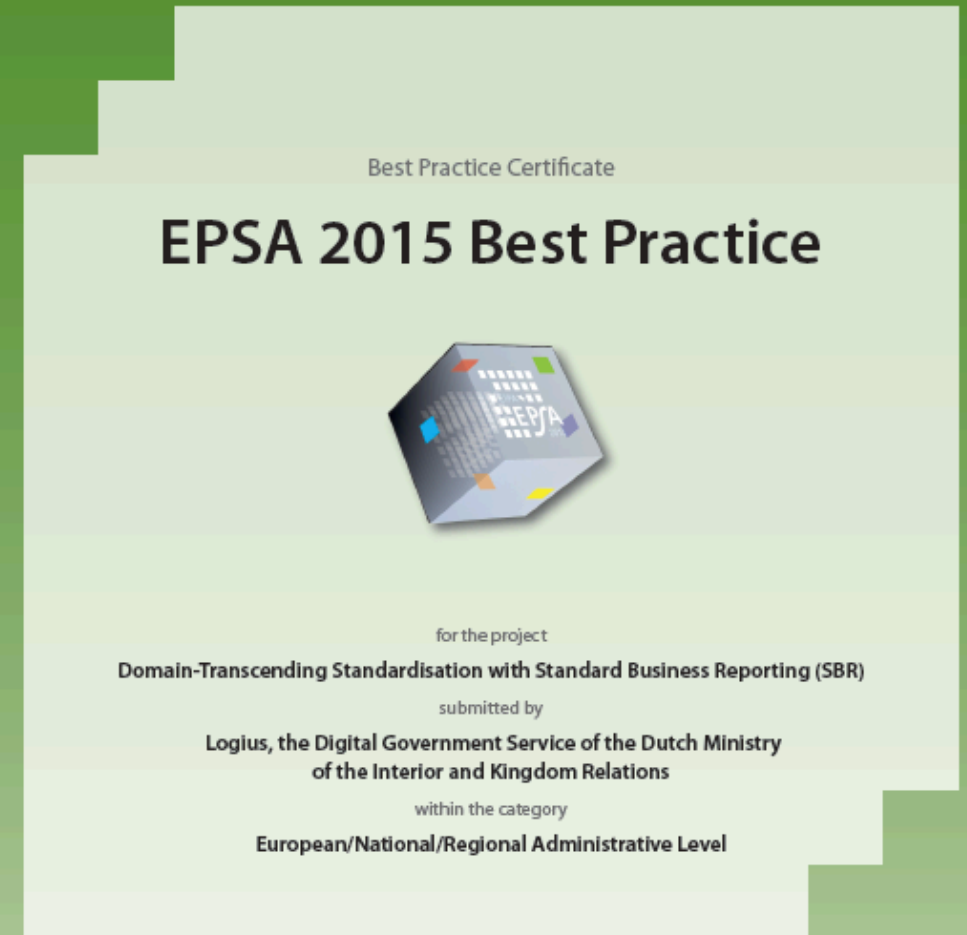
