


Introduction

It maintains government-wide ICT solutions and common standards, that **simplify the communication** between authorities, citizens and businesses.



What is Digipoort


- Demand for digital, systemto-system information exchange; both government and business
- Declaration of Tallinn and Digital Single Market
 Strategy call for interoperability
- Need for uniformity, based on open standards





What is Digipoort

- Digipoort is the digital gateway for B2G and G2G information exchange
- Standardization of communication
- Data exchange based on laws & regulations
- Uniform application programming interface
 (API)






Why Digipoort & SBR

2003:

- Administrative burden on businesses relatively high
- > € 13-16 billion* /year
- > 2.9-3.7% GDP





Reduce the burden

- Preventing new regulatory burdens
- High-trust approach (cooperation private sector)
- Smart Regulation (cooperation EU)
- Improving level of service, including ICT: Standard
 Business Reporting
 → € 350-900 million /year



Why Digipoort & SBR


Eliminate obstacles for automation:

- Standardize on data definitions, processes & technology

- Machine-to-machine reporting




Results & lessons learnt


